by these presents do and each of them doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, release and confirm unto the said Mary Galavan her heirs and assigns for
ever. All that certain tract or parcel of Land situate and lying on the
Western side of the old Macatic Road in the County of Guysborough and Province
aforesaid which is bounded and described as follows, viz: Beginning on the
Western side of the aforesaid Road at a Stake marked T. M. at the south East
angle of a Lot surveyed for Michael Murphy three North forty four degrees
West, ninety four chains, thence South fifteen degrees West thirty chains or

Between the Honourable William Frederick Fraser at his residence at 10. St. John Street, — Des Barres of Belmont, in the County of Hants in the Province of Nova Scotia and Maria Sophia Des Barres 1855, wife of the said Alexr. Fraser upon and between them the said Des Barres one of the subscribers thereto in the County of Guysborough and Province aforesaid witnessed by me the said Justice of the Peace. Will mete & tell that

William Moir the said William Frederick Des Barres and Maria Sophia Des Barres for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred pounds of lawful money of the Province of Nova Scotia to them paid and truly paid by the said Alexander Fraser upon or immediately before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have and take of them full granted, bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these presents do and each of them doth grant, bargain sell alien enfeoff release and confirm unto the said Alexander Fraser his heirs and assigns for ever. All that certain lot or tract of Land situated and lying at the said River Settlement in the County of Guysborough aforesaid now in the possession of the said Alexander Fraser Containing Two Hundred acres more or less, Bounded Northwardly by lands now or formerly belonging to James Gleyght, and southerly by lands formerly granted to Samuel Forbes being the same tract of land formerly granted by the Crown to one Henry Williams by Grant bearing date the ninth day of January in the Year of One thousand eight hundred and thirty two, and which is described in the Plan annexed to said Grant as being in two Lots adjoining each other, viz. Lot No. Eight letter D containing one hundred acres and Lot No Nine letter E also containing One hundred acres together with all houses outbuildings ways waters watercourses easements profits Commodities and Appurtenances whatsoever to the said Lot of land and premises belonging or in any wise abuttinging on to or with the same usually occupied
