 Western side of the old Hackensack Road in the County of Montgomery and Province

Have and each of them full granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed, released
and confirmed and by these presents do and each of them doth grant, bargain
sell, alien, convey, release and confirm unto the said Alexander Fraser his
heirs and assigns forever. All that certain lot or tract of Land situate and lying
at the Cascade River settlement in the County of Guysborough aforesaid now in the
possession of the said Alexander Fraser containing Two Hundred acres more
or less bounded Northerly by lands now or formerly belonging to James
Gleight, and Southerly by lands formerly granted to Samuel Arbut
being the same tract of land formerly granted by the Crown to one Henry
Williams by Grant bearing date the seventh day of January in the Year
of One thousand eight hundred and thirty two, and which is described
on the Plan annexed to said Grant as being in two Lots adjoining each other
Viz. Lot No. Eight letter III. containing one hundred acres and Lot No. Nine
letter II. also containing one hundred acres together with all houses outhouses
buildings, woods, waters, watercourses, easements, profits, Commodities and
Appurtenances, whatsoever to the said Lot of land and premises belonging or
in any wise appertaining or to or with the same usually occupied.
